Carolyn Burke is a well-known local author. She will speak about her latest book, *Foursome: Alfred Stieglitz, Georgia O'Keeffe, Paul Strand, Rebecca Salsbury*. The book was recently featured in the New York Review of books.

Her other books include *No Regrets: The Life of Edith Piaf*; *Lee Miller: A Life* (finalist for the National Book Critics Circle biography award)

Carolyn spent time with Lee Miller while working on her first book, *Becoming Modern: The Life of Mina Loy*. The definitive biography of the expatriate artist/poet, it sparked a major Loy revival.

Her writing has appeared in such places as *Art in America*, *Vogue*, *La Nouvelle Revue Française*, and *The New Yorker*. She has taught life-writing at book festivals and universities in the U.S., Australia, New Zealand, and France.

Carolyn is a member of PEN and the Authors Guild. A student of Zen Buddhism, born in Sydney, Australia, she now lives in Santa Cruz.
